

## Minutes of Special Meeting of the Board of Alderman For the city of Valley View, Texas February 13, 2024

- 1. Call meeting to order Mayor Bewley. Alderman Haymaker was not in attendance.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance & Invocation Mayor Bewley
- **3.** Discuss and take appropriate action for TxDot Application for funding for sewer line movement at main line.

City engineer explained to the board a call he had with TxDot about application for funding for sewer line movement. TxDot requires we have board approval to start the process with the application.

## Mayor Pro Tem Wilkerson made a motion pending legal approval to start the process with the application with TxDot. Alderman Hiesler seconded the motion and the motion passed 4-0

4. Discuss and take appropriate action for Kiwanis club to have a kick ball tournament at City Park.

5. Discuss and take appropriate action on an Election Order for a General Election on May 4, 2024 for seats 2, 4, and 6, each for two-year terms, on the board of Aldermen.

6. Discuss and take appropriate action for representative for onsite sewer. The rep we are using from Gainesville can no longer help us and would like us to find a new rep. Kevin said he would take the class to be a representative for Valley View.

Mayor Pro Tem Wilkerson made a motion to allow Todd Daniel to be representative for onsite sewer until Kevin Ware can acquire the license to allow him to be the City representative. Alderman Hiesler seconded the motion and the motion passed 4-0
